Policies and Procedures During COVID 19
Rental & School Participants

The health and welfare of everyone working and participating in track events at Mid-Ohio is paramount and this document and the attachments are meant to guide each participant when planning a rental or school event at Mid-Ohio Sports Car Course. Please know that everyone needs to do their part to follow the State of Ohio's protocols for being in public places as well as guidelines that we have put in place locally.

NOTE: SOCIAL DISTANCING PRACTICES MUST BE MAINTAINED
WEAR A MASK WHENEVER YOU ARE NOT PARTICIPATING ON TRACK
WASH YOUR HANDS WITH SOAP AND WATER FREQUENTLY AND USE THE PROVIDED HAND SANITIZER
DON'T TOUCH YOUR FACE

Rental & School Participants

Rental & School participants of Mid-Ohio:

- All participants enter/exit via Gate #3
- All participants must have a COVID-19 health screen questionnaire completed prior to entering the facility. **This document will be sent prior to event & can also be filled out onsite**
 - Completed forms should be filled out and give to security guard at Gate #3
- All participants will have their temperature checked prior to entering the racetrack and will be required to have it checked upon exit and re-entry.
- All participants must wear a mask at all times during their visit unless you are wearing a driving/riding helmet for on track activity.

Miscellaneous

Mid-Ohio Sports Car Course encourages all rental & school participants to follow the recommendations set forth by the CDC, such as **frequently washing your hands, use of hand sanitizer, covering your mouth when you cough or sneeze as well as practicing social distancing at all times (minimum of 6 feet).**

Ongoing Efforts:

Mid-Ohio management advises that a proactive approach be taken, and additional measures are created per club/group/school to help minimize the spread of any viruses.

Those measures include but are not limited to:

- Social Distancing should still be practiced at all times!
- Gate staff and volunteers (registration, security, etc.) should be issued gloves and facemask.
- Equipment with high-contact rates (radios, headsets, clipboards, pens etc.) should be sanitized before and between uses when they are shared.

- Events where loaner helmets are provided (i.e. driving schools), balaclavas (head socks) disinfectant spray should be offered and used after use.
- Any driver/rider meetings normally held indoors should be conducted outside wherever possible and social distancing should be observed.
- Minimize direct, physical contact between event attendees as much as possible. This includes, but is not limited to, event social functions, again practicing social distancing.
- Health officials have repeatedly stated that the best defense against COVID-19 is to practice good hygiene by washing hands regularly and using hand sanitizer.

For your convenience, additional hand sanitizer stations have been added throughout the facility, paddock and garage areas. Event participants are encouraged to use them as often as possible.

- Hand sanitizer locations

 - Registration
 - Security
 - Medical
 - Operations Bldg.
 - Garage area
 - Pit lane
 - Concession stand
 - Tower
 - 2nd Floor
 - Base

End of day social gatherings, parties, cookouts etc. are prohibited at this time.

Mid-Ohio Sports Car Course leadership will continue to monitor the CDC and communicate with other official local/state/national agencies and may adjust plans accordingly based on further updates and/or restrictions imposed. Together we can continue to prevent the spread of the coronavirus.
